# Slovenia: Standards

---

National regulation introduced: 2001

Topics regulated: general provisions, plant and animal production, beekeeping, aquaculture, inspection, labelling, certification

Key differences to EU Regulation 2092/91:

- Regulation of aquaculture
- No significant other differences (AWI by Bartussek...)

Problems areas organic livestock:

- Housing and exercise area (appropriate stables, open-air runs)
- Fodder (availability, price, GMO-free)
- Availability of organic animals
