Certified Land area in 2003: 254 995 ha (5,97%)

Number of producers in 2003: 810 farms

of which livestock producers: 346 farms

Development:

1990 – 480 ha – 3 farms

1993 – 15 667 ha – 141 farms

1997 – 20 239 ha – 211 farms

2000 – 165 669 ha – 536 farms

Certification bodies: K.E.Z. o.p.s. – Accredited
by IFOAM and EU (Reg. 2092/91 and 1804/99)

National organic farming support introduced:
1990 – 1993 and 1997 – today

Supports: arable soil – 113 Euro/ha

permenent grassland – 35 Euro/ha

vegetable – 356 Euro/ha

Czech republic: Standards

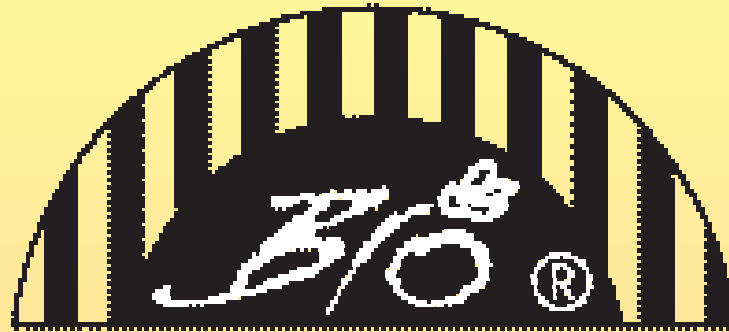
National regulation introduced: 2000 (law nr. 242/2000 sb. – harmonized with ECC 2092/91, 1804/99

It is regulated: plant and animal production, processing, export, import, denoting and control
